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Approved Bases for Public Records Exemption

- Law enforcement personnel, including correctional officers and correctional probation officers. **
- Civilian personnel employed by a law enforcement agency. **
- Department of Children and Family Services personnel whose duties involve investigation of abuse, neglect, exploitation, fraud, theft, or other criminal activities. **
- Department of Health personnel whose duties support the investigations of child abuse or neglect. **
- Department of Revenue personnel or local government personnel whose duties include revenue collection and enforcement or child support enforcement. **
- Department of Financial Services personnel whose duties include the investigation of fraud, theft, workers' compensation coverage requirements and compliance, other related criminal activities, or state regulatory requirement violations. **
- Office of Financial Regulation's Bureau of Financial Investigations whose duties include the investigation of fraud, theft, other related criminal activities, or state regulatory requirement violations. **
- Firefighter certified in compliance with F.S. 633.408. **
- Justices of the Supreme Court, district court of appeal judges, circuit court judges, and county court judges. **
- State attorneys, assistant state attorneys, statewide prosecutors, or assistant statewide prosecutors. **
- General magistrates, special magistrates, judges of compensation claims, administrative law judges of the Division of Administrative Hearings, and child support enforcement hearing officers. *
- Human resource, labor relations, or employee relations directors; assistant directors, managers, or assistant managers of any local government agency or water management district whose duties include hiring and firing employees, labor contract negotiation, administration, or other personnel-related duties. **
- Code Enforcement Officers. **
- Guardians ad litem as defined in F.S. 39.820. **
- Juvenile probation officers, juvenile probation supervisors, detention superintendents, assistant detention superintendents, juvenile justice detention officers I and II, juvenile justice detention officer supervisors, juvenile justice residential officers, juvenile justice residential officer supervisors I and II, juvenile justice counselors, juvenile justice counselor supervisors, human services counselor administrators, senior human services counselor administrators, rehabilitation therapists, and social services counselors of the Department of Juvenile Justice. **
- Public defenders, assistant public defenders, criminal conflict and civil regional counsel, and assistant criminal conflict and civil regional counsel. **
- Investigators or inspectors of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. **
- County Tax Collectors. *
- Personnel of the Department of Health whose duties include, or result in, the determination or adjudication of eligibility for social security disability benefits, the investigation or prosecution of complaints filed against health care practitioners, or the inspection of health care practitioners or health care facilities licensed by the Department of Health. **
- Impaired practitioner consultants who are retained by an agency or employees of an impaired practitioner consultant whose duties result in a determination of a person's skill and safety to practice a licensed profession. **
- Emergency medical technicians or paramedics certified under chapter 401, F.S. **
- Office of inspector general or internal audit department whose duties include auditing or investigating waste, fraud, abuse, theft, exploitation, or other activities that could lead to criminal prosecution or administrative discipline. **
- Directors, managers, supervisors, nurses, and clinical employees of an addiction treatment facility. **
- Directors, managers, supervisors, and clinical employees of a child advocacy center that meets the standards of s. 39.3035(1) and fulfills the screening requirement of s. 39.3035(2), and the members of a Child Protection Team as described in s. 39.303 whose duties include supporting the investigation of child abuse or sexual abuse, child abandonment, child neglect, and child exploitation or to provide services as part of a multidisciplinary case review team. **
- Member of U.S. Armed Forces, reserve component of U.S. Armed Forces, or National Guard who served after 9/11/2001. **
- U.S. Attorney or Assistant U.S. Attorney, U.S. circuit judge, U.S. district judge, or U.S. magistrate judge. **
- Staff and domestic violence advocates of domestic violence centers certified by the Department of Children and Families under chapter 39, F.S. **
